AND THOU WILT NOT SAVE!

☞Psalm 13:1, 2 To the chief  
Musician, A Psalm of David. How  
long wilt thou forget me, O  
LORD? for ever? how long wilt  
thou hide thy face from me?  
2 How long shall I take counsel in  
my soul, having sorrow in my  
heart daily? how long shall mine  
enemy be exalted over me?

☞Psalm 74:9, 10 We see not our  
signs: there is no more any  
prophet: neither is there among us  
any that knoweth how long.  
10 O God, how long shall the  
adversary reproach? shall the  
enemy blaspheme thy name for  
ever?

☞Psalm 94:3 LORD, how long  
shall the wicked, how long shall  
the wicked triumph?

☞Revelation 6:10 And they cried  
with a loud voice, saying, How  
long, O Lord, holy and true, dost  
thou not judge and avenge our

blood on them that dwell on the

UP STRIFE AND  
CONTENTION.

☞Psalm 12:1, 2 To the chief  
Musician upon Sheminith, A  
Psalm of David. Help, LORD; for

the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men.

2 They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak.

☞Psalm 55:9-11 Destroy, O Lord, and divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city. 10 Day and night they go about it upon the walls thereof: mischief also and sorrow are in the midst of it.

11 Wickedness is in the midst thereof: deceit and guile depart not from her streets.

☞Psalm 73:3-9 For I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

4 For there are no bands in their death: but their strength is firm.

5 They are not in trouble as other men; neither are they plagued like other men.

6 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them as a garment.

7 Their eyes stand out with fatness: they have more than heart could wish.

8 They are corrupt, and speak wickedly concerning oppression: they speak loftily.

9 They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walketh through the earth.

☞Psalm 120:5, 6 Woe is me, that I sojourn in Mesech, that I dwell in the tents of Kedar!

6 My soul hath long dwelt with him that hateth peace.

☞Ecclesiastes 4:1 So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of such as were oppressed, and they had no comforter; and on the side of their oppressors there was power; but they had no comforter.

☞Ecclesiastes 5:8 If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for he that is higher than the highest regardeth; and there be higher than they.

☞Jeremiah 9:2-6 Oh that I had in the wilderness a lodging place of wayfaring men; that I might leave my people, and go from them! for they be all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men.

3 And they bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD.

4 Take ye heed every one of his neighbour, and trust ye not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbour will walk with slanders.

5 And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity.  
6 Thine habitation is in the midst of deceit; through deceit they refuse to know me, saith the LORD.

☞Ezekiel 2:6 And thou, son of man, be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns be with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they be a rebellious house.

☞Micah 7:1-3 Woe is me! for I am as when they have gathered the summer fruits, as the grape gleanings of the vintage: there is no cluster to eat: my soul desired the firstripe fruit.  
2 The good man is perished out of the earth: and there is none upright among men: they all lie in wait for blood; they hunt every man his brother with a net.  
3 That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asketh, and the judge asketh for a reward; and the great man, he uttereth his mischievous desire: so they wrap it up.  
4 The best of them is as a brier: the most upright is sharper than a thorn hedge: the day of thy watchmen and thy visitation

cometh; now shall be their perplexity.

☞Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

☞2 Peter 2:8 (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;)

**4 THEREFORE THE LAW IS SLACKED, AND JUDGMENT DOTHTH NEVER GO FORTH: FOR THE WICKED DOTHTH COMPASS ABOUT THE RIGHTEOUS; THEREFORE WRONG JUDGMENT PROCEEDETH.**

☞Psalm 11:3 If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?

☞Psalm 119:126 It is time for thee, LORD, to work: for they have made void thy law.

☞Mark 7:9 And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

☞Romans 3:31 Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

☞1 Kings 21:13 And there came in two men, children of Belial, and sat before him: and the men of Belial witnessed against him, even against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.

☞Job 21:7 Wherefore do the wicked live, become old, yea, are mighty in power?

☞Psalm 22:16 For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.

☞Psalm 58:1, 2 To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David. Do ye indeed speak righteousness, O congregation? do ye judge uprightly, O ye sons of men?

2 Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the violence of your hands in the earth.

☞Psalm 59:2 Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men.

☞Psalm 59:4 They run and prepare themselves without my fault: awake to help me, and behold.

☞Psalm 82:1-5 A Psalm of Asaph. God standeth in the congregation

of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods.

2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah.

3 Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy.

4 Deliver the poor and needy: rid them out of the hand of the wicked.

5 They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course.

☞Psalm 94:3, 20. 21 LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph?

20 Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law?

21 They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood.

☞Isaiah 1:21-23 How is the faithful city become an harlot! it was full of judgment; righteousness lodged in it; but now murderers.

22 Thy silver is become dross, thy wine mixed with water:

23 Thy princes are rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

☞Jeremiah 46:1 The word of the LORD which came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Gentiles;

☞Jeremiah 47:1, 2 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Philistines, before that Pharaoh smote Gaza. Jeremiah 47:2 Thus saith the LORD; Behold, waters rise up out of the north, and shall be an overflowing flood, and shall overflow the land, and all that is therein; the city, and them that dwell therein: then the men shall cry, and all the inhabitants of the land shall howl.

Jeremiah 52:1-5 Zedekiah was one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah. 2 And he did that which was evil in the eyes of the LORD, according to all that Jehoiakim had done.

3 For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

4 And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, that Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon came, he and all his army, against Jerusalem, and

pitched against it, and built forts against it round about. 5 So the city was besieged unto the eleventh year of king Zedekiah.

☞Ezekiel 25:1 The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying,

☞Ezekiel 26:1 And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in the first day of the month, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

☞Ezekiel 27:1 The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying,

☞Ezekiel 29:1 In the tenth year, in the tenth month, in the twelfth day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

not his! how long? and to him that

7 Shall they not rise up suddenly  
that shall bite thee, and awake that  
shall vex thee, and thou shalt be  
for booties unto them?

8 Because thou hast spoiled many  
nations, all the remnant of the  
people shall spoil thee; because of  
men's blood, and for the violence  
of the land, of the city, and of all  
that dwell therein.

17 For the violence of Lebanon  
shall cover thee, and the spoil of  
beasts, which made them afraid,  
because of men's blood, and for  
the violence of the land, of the  
city, and of all that dwell therein.

☞Isaiah 14:16, 17 They that see  
thee shall narrowly look upon thee,  
and consider thee, saying, Is this  
the man that made the earth to  
tremble, that did shake kingdoms;  
17 That made the world as a  
wilderness, and destroyed the  
cities thereof; that opened not the  
house of his prisoners?

Jeremiah 25:9-13 Behold, I will  
send and take all the families of  
the north, saith the LORD, and  
Nebuchadrezzar the king of  
Babylon, my servant, and will  
bring them against this land, and  
against the inhabitants thereof, and  
against all these nations round  
about, and will utterly destroy  
them, and make them an

astonishment, and an hissing, and  
perpetual desolations.

10 Moreover I will take from them  
the voice of mirth, and the voice of  
gladness, the voice of the  
bridegroom, and the voice of the  
bride, the sound of the millstones,  
and the light of the candle.

11 And this whole land shall be a  
desolation, and an astonishment;  
and these nations shall serve the  
king of Babylon seventy years.

12 And it shall come to pass, when  
seventy years are accomplished,  
that I will punish the king of  
Babylon, and that nation, saith the  
LORD, for their iniquity, and the  
land of the Chaldeans, and will  
make it perpetual desolations.

13 And I will bring upon that land  
all my words which I have  
pronounced against it, even all that  
is written in this book, which  
Jeremiah hath prophesied against  
all the nations.

☞Jeremiah 48:1 Against Moab  
thus saith the LORD of hosts, the  
God of Israel; Woe unto Nebo! for  
it is spoiled: Kiriathaim is  
confounded and taken: Misgab is  
confounded and dismayed.

☞Jeremiah 49:1 Concerning the  
Ammonites, thus saith the LORD;  
Hath Israel no sons? hath he no  
heir? why then doth their king  
inherit Gad, and his people dwell  
in his cities?

☞Isaiah 59:2-8, 13-15 But your  
iniquities have separated between  
you and your God, and your sins  
have hid his face from you, that he  
will not hear.

3 For your hands are defiled with  
blood, and your fingers with  
iniquity; your lips have spoken  
lies, your tongue hath muttered  
perverseness.

4 None calleth for justice, nor any  
pleadeth for truth: they trust in  
vanity, and speak lies; they  
conceive mischief, and bring forth  
iniquity.

5 They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and  
weave the spider's web: he that  
eateth of their eggs dieth, and that  
which is crushed breaketh out into  
a viper.

6 Their webs shall not become  
garments, neither shall they cover  
themselves with their works: their  
works are works of iniquity, and  
the act of violence is in their  
hands.

7 Their feet run to evil, and they  
make haste to shed innocent blood:  
their thoughts are thoughts of  
iniquity; wasting and destruction  
are in their paths.

8 The way of peace they know not;  
and there is no judgment in their  
goings: they have made them  
crooked paths: whosoever goeth  
therein shall not know peace.

13 In transgressing and lying  
against the LORD, and departing  
away from our God, speaking  
oppression and revolt, conceiving

and uttering from the heart words  
of falsehood.

14 And judgment is turned away  
backward, and justice standeth afar  
off: for truth is fallen in the street,  
and equity cannot enter.

15 Yea, truth faileth; and he that  
departeth from evil maketh himself  
a prey: and the LORD saw it, and  
it displeased him that there was no  
judgment.

☞Jeremiah 5:27-29 As a cage is  
full of birds, so are their houses  
full of deceit: therefore they are  
become great, and waxen rich.

28 They are waxen fat, they shine:  
yea, they overpass the deeds of the  
wicked: they judge not the cause,  
the cause of the fatherless, yet they  
prosper; and the right of the needy  
do they not judge.

29 Shall I not visit for these  
things? saith the LORD: shall not  
my soul be avenged on such a  
nation as this?

☞Jeremiah 12:1, 6 Righteous art  
thou, O LORD, when I plead with  
thee: yet let me talk with thee of  
thy judgments: Wherefore doth the  
way of the wicked prosper?  
wherefore are all they happy that  
deal very treacherously?

6 For even thy brethren, and the  
house of thy father, even they have  
dealt treacherously with thee; yea,  
they have called a multitude after  
thee: believe them not, though they  
speak fair words unto thee.

☞Jeremiah 26:8, 21-23 Now it came to pass, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded him to speak unto all the people, that the priests and the prophets and all the people took him, saying, Thou shalt surely die.

21 And when Jehoiakim the king, with all his mighty men, and all the princes, heard his words, the king sought to put him to death: but when Urijah heard it, he was afraid, and fled, and went into Egypt;

22 And Jehoiakim the king sent men into Egypt, namely, Elnathan the son of Achbor, and certain men with him into Egypt.

23 And they fetched forth Urijah out of Egypt, and brought him unto Jehoiakim the king; who slew him with the sword, and cast his dead body into the graves of the common people.

☞Jeremiah 37:14-16 Then said Jeremiah, It is false; I fall not away to the Chaldeans. But he hearkened not to him: so Irijah took Jeremiah, and brought him to the princes.

15 Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison.

16 When Jeremiah was entered into the dungeon, and into the cabins, and Jeremiah had remained

there many days;

☞Jeremiah 38:4-6 Therefore the princes said unto the king, We beseech thee, let this man be put to death: for thus he weakeneth the hands of the men of war that remain in this city, and the hands of all the people, in speaking such words unto them: for this man seeketh not the welfare of this people, but the hurt.

5 Then Zedekiah the king said, Behold, he is in your hand: for the king is not he that can do any thing against you.

6 Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that was in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon there was no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

☞Ezekiel 22:25-30 There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof.

26 Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their

☞Isaiah 37:24 By thy servants hast thou reproached the Lord, and hast said, By the multitude of my chariots am I come up to the height of the mountains, to the sides of Lebanon; and I will cut down the tall cedars thereof, and the choice fir trees thereof: and I will enter into the height of his border, and the forest of his Carmel.

☞Ezekiel 28:3 Behold, thou art wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee:

☞Ezekiel 29:3 Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river is mine own, and I have made it for myself.

☞Daniel 4:30 The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?

☞Daniel 5:23 But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou,

and thy lords, thy wives, and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, hast thou not glorified:

**17 SHALL THEY THEREFORE EMPTY THEIR NET, AND NOT SPARE CONTINUALLY TO SLAY THE NATIONS?**

☞Habakkuk 1:9, 10 They shall come all for violence: their faces shall sup up as the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand.

10 And they shall scoff at the kings, and the princes shall be a scorn unto them: they shall deride every strong hold; for they shall heap dust, and take it.

☞Habakkuk 2:5-8, 17 Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, he is a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

6 Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth that which is

daughter of Jerusalem, saying, Is this the city that men call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?

16 All thine enemies have opened their mouth against thee: they hiss and gnash the teeth: they say, We have swallowed her up: certainly this is the day that we looked for; we have found, we have seen it.

☞Ezekiel 25:6 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast clapped thine hands, and stamped with the feet, and rejoiced in heart with all thy despite against the land of Israel;

☞Ezekiel 26:2 Son of man, because that Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken that was the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, now she is laid waste:

☞Ezekiel 35:15 As thou didst rejoice at the inheritance of the house of Israel, because it was desolate, so will I do unto thee: thou shalt be desolate, O mount Seir, and all Idumea, even all of it: and they shall know that I am the LORD.

☞Revelation 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets

tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

16 THEREFORE THEY SACRIFICE UNTO THEIR NET, AND BURN INCENSE UNTO THEIR DRAG; BECAUSE BY THEM THEIR PORTION IS FAT, AND THEIR MEAT PLENTIFUL.

☞Habakkuk 1:11 Then shall his mind change, and he shall pass over, and offend, imputing this his power unto his god.

☞Deuteronomy 8:17 And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth.

☞Isaiah 10:13, 14 For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done it, and by my wisdom; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant man:

14 And my hand hath found as a nest the riches of the people: and as one gathereth eggs that are left, have I gathered all the earth; and there was none that moved the wing, or opened the mouth, or peeped.

☞Isaiah 10:15 Shall the axe boast itself against him that heweth therewith? or shall the saw

eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

27 Her princes in the midst thereof are like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, and to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain.

28 And her prophets have daubed them with untempered mortar, seeing vanity, and divining lies unto them, saying, Thus saith the Lord GOD, when the LORD hath not spoken.

29 The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully. 30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

☞Hosea 10:4 They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a covenant: thus judgment springeth up as hemlock in the furrows of the field.

☞Amos 5:7, 12 Ye who turn judgment to wormwood, and leave off righteousness in the earth, 12 For I know your manifold transgressions and your mighty sins: they afflict the just, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate from their right.

☞Micah 2:1 Woe to them that devise iniquity, and work evil

upon their beds! when the morning is light, they practise it, because it is in the power of their hand.

2 And they covet fields, and take them by violence; and houses, and take them away: so they oppress a man and his house, even a man and his heritage.

☞Micah 3:1-3 And I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and ye princes of the house of Israel; Is it not for you to know judgment?

2 Who hate the good, and love the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones;

3 Who also eat the flesh of my people, and flay their skin from off them; and they break their bones, and chop them in pieces, as for the pot, and as flesh within the caldron.

☞Micah 7:2-4 The good man is perished out of the earth: and there is none upright among men: they all lie in wait for blood; they hunt every man his brother with a net.

3 That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asketh, and the judge asketh for a reward; and the great man, he uttereth his mischievous desire: so they wrap it up.

☞Matthew 23:34-36 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city: 35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar. 36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

☞Matthew 26:59-63 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death; 60 But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses, 61 And said, This fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days. 62 And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what is it which these witness against thee? 63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

☞Matthew 27:1, 2, 25, 26 When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death: 2 And when they had bound him, they led him away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor. 25 Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children. 26 Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified.

☞Act 7:52, 59 Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they have slain them which shewed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers: 59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

☞Act 23:12-14 And when it was day, certain of the Jews banded together, and bound themselves under a curse, saying that they would neither eat nor drink till they had killed Paul. 13 And they were more than forty which had made this conspiracy. 14 And they came to the chief priests and elders, and said, We have bound ourselves under a great curse, that we will eat nothing until we have slain Paul.

lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

☞Psalm 10:9 He lieth in wait secretly as a lion in his den: he lieth in wait to catch the poor: he doth catch the poor, when he draweth him into his net.

☞v. 6 For, lo, I raise up the Chaldeans, that bitter and hasty nation, which shall march through the breadth of the land, to possess the dwellingplaces that are not theirs.

☞Habakkuk 2:5 Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, he is a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

6 Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth that which is not his! how long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

7 Shall they not rise up suddenly that shall bite thee, and awake that shall vex thee, and thou shalt be for booties unto them?

8 Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and for the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

9 Woe to him that coveteth an evil covetousness to his house, that he may set his nest on high, that he may be delivered from the power of evil!

☞Deuteronomy 28:51, 52 And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which also shall not leave thee either corn, wine, or oil, or the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

52 And he shall besiege thee in all thy gates, until thy high and fenced

walls come down, wherein thou trustedst, throughout all thy land: and he shall besiege thee in all thy gates throughout all thy land, which the LORD thy God hath given thee.

☞Psalm 93:2 Thy throne is established of old: thou art from everlasting.

☞Isaiah 40:28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.

☞2 Kings 24:12 And Jehoiachin the king of Judah went out to the king of Babylon, he, and his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the eighth year of his reign.

☞2 Kings 25:6, 7 So they took the king, and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah; and they gave judgment upon him. 7 And they slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, and put out the eyes of Zedekiah, and bound him with fetters of brass, and carried him to Babylon.

☞2 Chronicles 36:6, 10 Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him in fetters, to carry him to Babylon. 10 And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

☞Isaiah 14:16 They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;

☞Jeremiah 32:24 Behold the mounts, they are come unto the city to take it; and the city is given into the hand of the Chaldeans, that fight against it, because of the sword, and of the famine, and of the pestilence: and what thou hast spoken is come to pass; and, behold, thou seest it.

☞Jeremiah 33:4 For thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel,

concerning the houses of this city, and concerning the houses of the kings of Judah, which are thrown down by the mounts, and by the sword;

☞Jeremiah 52:4-7 And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he and all his army, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it, and built forts against it round about.

5 So the city was besieged unto the eleventh year of king Zedekiah.

6 And in the fourth month, in the ninth day of the month, the famine was sore in the city, so that there was no bread for the people of the land.

7 Then the city was broken up, and all the men of war fled, and went forth out of the city by night by the way of the gate between the two walls, which was by the king's garden; (now the Chaldeans were by the city round about:) and they went by the way of the plain.

☞Daniel 4:30-34 The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon,

that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?

31 While the word was in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven, saying, O king Nebuchadnezzar, to thee it is spoken; The kingdom is departed from thee.

32 And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field: they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and seven times shall pass over thee, until thou know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

33 The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' feathers, and his nails like birds' claws.

34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:
