

Psalm 82

1 God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods.

- *2 Chronicles 19:6* . And said to the judges, Take heed what ye do; for ye judge not for man, but for the LORD, who is with you in the judgment.
- *Deuteronomy 19:17* Then both the men, between whom the controversy is, shall stand before the LORD, before the priests and the judges, which shall be in those days;
- *Ecclesiastes 5:8* If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter; for he that is higher than the highest regardeth; and there be higher than they.

2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah.

Psalm 82

- *Exodus 18:22 “ And let them judge the people at all seasons:...”*
- *Exodus 22:9 “For all manner of trespasss...the cause of both parties shall come before the judges;...”*
- *Deuteronomy 1:16 . And I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear the causes between your brethren, and judge righteously between every man and his brother, and the stranger that is with him.*
- *Deuteronomy 16:18 Judges and officers shalt thou make thee in all thy gates, throughout thy tribes: and they shall judge which the LORD thy God giveth thee, the people with just judgment.*
- *Deuteronomy 25:1 “Off there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that the judges may judge them;*

- *Genesis 15:14* . And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.
- *Genesis 18:25* That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

- *Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. 11 And I saw heaven opened, and beheld a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war:*
- *Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.*

- *1 Peter 4:5* *Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead. 6* *For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.*
- *Revelation 6:10* *And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and*

- *Isaiah 33:22* *For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; he will save us.*
- *Matthew 7:1* *Judge not, that ye be not judged. 2* *For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what*

- *1 Corinthians 5:3 For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed, 12 For what have I to do to judge them also that are without? do not ye judge them that are within? 13 But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.*
- *James 2:4 Are ye not then partial in yourselves, and are become judges of evil thoughts? 12 So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.*
- *James 4:11 Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge. 12 There is one*

- measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. 3. And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?*
- *Luke 6:37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned; forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:*
 - *Luke 7:43 Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.*
 - *John 5:22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:*
 - *John 5:30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own*

- 1 Corinthians 2:15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

- 1 Corinthians 4:3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self: 4 For I know nothing by myself, yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord. 5 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.
